The 2010 DOROTHY SKELTON SCHOLARSHIP Patron Art Show



Dorothy Skelton

was a local artist and a firm believer in the importance of art education. When Dorothy passed away in 1999, her family donated her collection of art to the Windmore Foundation. Windmore

established an scholarship in Dorothy's memory using this collection. The proceeds from the patron art show funds this scholarship which is awarded annually to students in Culpeper, Madison, Orange, and Rappahannock counties that are pursuing degrees in the arts.

Patron Art Show

This juried show is open to all artists, and there is no entry fee. Original fine art in any medium may be donated, and a guest ticket for the closing reception will be given to the donor for each piece of accepted artwork. A guest ticket may be upgraded to a patron ticket for \$75.

All 2-dimensional work should be neatly framed, clean, and ready for hanging with hooks and wires. **Reproductions, videos, and clip mounts are NOT permitted.**

At the closing reception, patron ticket holders will, in random order, select a piece of art to take home that evening. A viewer's choice award will be chosen that evening and a cash prize of \$100 will be awarded to the selected artist.

Awards & Benefits

The show will be displayed for 2 weeks prior to the closing reception. During the exhibition, an independent curator will award ribbons and cash prizes totaling \$600 to 3 selections which will then be set aside for special recognition and auction at the reception. Award winners will receive pre-event publicity.

A printed catalog of the show will be created that includes all artwork and a brief bio of each artist. A copy of the catalog will be given to each participating artist. Additional copies will be available for sale at the closing reception.

Windmore is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. You are entitled to deduct the cost of materials used in your artwork if your artwork is selected by a Patron.

Bins will be available for displaying a limited number of shrink-wrapped images for direct sale to attendees of the reception. A 10% commission will be assessed to bin sales. Please call ahead regarding the availability of bin space.
